



### Baker Street / Marylebone Road junction


Inspired by the Sherlock Holmes story, The Adventure of the Blue Carbuncle, the ornate lamppost columns marking the gateway to the Quarter feature illuminated geese sporting blue jewels (carbuncles).

### 55 Baker Street


As you approach this destination, look up into the trees to spot the bright yellow eccentric items that would have been for sale at the amazing and exotic Baker Street Bazaar. The fabulously popular bazaar was a huge draw in the 1800s - 1900s and the original home of the Madame Tussauds exhibition.

### Portman Square Garden

The shimmer of the blue and gold from the decorations in this garden are a subtle nod to Lady Montagu's 'Blue Stocking Parties' which were held in Montagu House (currently Nobu Hotel London Portman Square) on Portman Square for eminent intellectuals.

### Manchester Square Garden


